SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The GLFPD Scholarships are awarded based on the following criteria:

- Type of activity needing funding
- Other sources of funds being pursued by applicant
- Cumulative grade point average
- Extra-curricular activities
- Community and volunteer efforts
- Ability of applicant to match funding
- Volunteer or Community Service with GLFPD



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Scholarship Fund Application

Grand Lake Fire Protection District (GLFPD) has established a scholarship fund to assist students residing within the Fire District in furthering their academic or civic development. GLFPD's Scholarship Committee will review all applications and determine which requests are to be funded.

Each candidate shall:

- Complete the application package
- Be a current full-time resident in the Grand Lake Fire Protection District
- Be a full-time student in grades Kindergarten (K) through twelfth (12th)
- Provide a school transcript or copy of grade cards
- Provide a copy of the brochure or information for which funding is being requested

Applicants are eligible for one scholarship per calendar year or a maximum of \$500 in awards.

Other Considerations:

- Each scholarship may be up to \$500.
- Any exceptions to eligibility requirements or maximum scholarship amount noted above must be approved by the Scholarship Committee and Fire Chief. Decision by the Fire Chief is final.
- Scholarship awards are contingent upon the recipient participating in one (1) GLFPD community event or three (3) hours of community service with GLFPD within six (6) months of award.
