IT IS BOATING SEASON IN GRAND LAKE

GRAND LAKE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT IS PARTNERING WITH THE CHRISTOPHER MULLINEX WATER RESCUE FUND AS WELL AS MULTIPLE AGENCIES IN GRAND COUNTY TO BRING THE MESSAGE OF WATER SAFETY TO PEOPLE WHO USE OUR LAKES AND WATERWAYS WITH THE GOAL OF PREVENTING DROWNINGS.

WE ARE WORKING WITH THE MULLINEX FUND TO PROVIDE LIFE JACKETS TO RECREATIONAL USERS IN OUR AREA, AS WELL AS SET UP A LIFE JACKET LOANER PROGRAM ON THE LAKES AND ASSIST WITH PROVIDING PUBLIC EDUCATION AND TRAINING. WE HAVE REACHED OUR GOAL TO HAVE THE LIFE JACKETS AVAILABLE IN ALL LOCATIONS. ADDITIONALLY, WE WILL PARTICIPATE IN SCHOOL PRESENTATIONS ON WATER SAFETY IN MAY.

ONE OF THE PRIMARY GOALS OF THIS PARTNERSHIP IS TO ESTABLISH A LIFE JACKET LOANER PROGRAM, WHICH WILL PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR VISITORS TO BORROW LIFE JACKETS AT BOATING RAMPS, LOCAL BUSINESSES, AND OTHER LOCATIONS AROUND THE LAKES. WEARING A LIFE JACKET WHILE SWIMMING IN LAKES, AND RIVERS, AND WHILE BOATING IS IMPORTANT FOR YOUR SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF YOUR CHILDREN, FAMILY, AND FRIENDS.

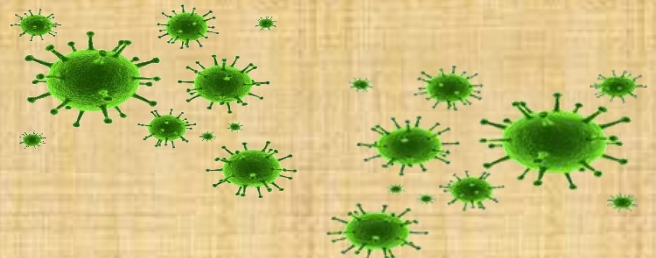

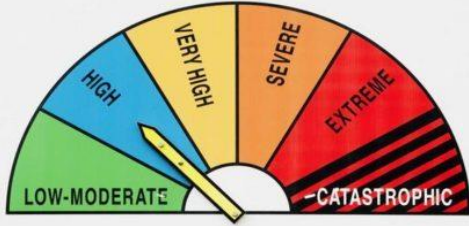

A Red Flag Warning, also known as a Fire Weather Warning, is a forecast warning issued by the National Weather Service to inform area firefighting and land management agencies that conditions are ideal for wildland fire ignition and rapid propagation.

After drought conditions and when humidity is very

low, and especially when high or erratic winds (which may include lightning) are a factor, the

Red Flag Warning becomes a critical statement for firefighting agencies. They usually include the daily vegetation moisture content calculations, expected afternoon high temperature, afternoon minimum relative humidity and daytime wind speed.

To the public, a Red Flag Warning means high fire danger with increased probability of a quickly spreading vegetation fire in the area within 24 hours.

ALWAYS CHECK THE WEATHER AND NOT BURN DURING RED FLAG WARNINGS.
